There are various Challenges tailored to different sectors and stages, so it doesn't matter if your business idea is at an early stage or fully fledged - we can help you take it to the next level.




Why should I apply?




What does it cost?

Our world-class entrepreneurial training is delivered through a mix of online on-demand modules and face-to-face sessions including masterclasses and networking events.

Later on in the programme, finalists in the Converge, Create Change and Net Zero Challenges will also receive extra training on routes to market, funding and investor-readiness, in preparation for taking your business to the next level.
